## The Soap Box Derby

It has been over 55 years since the last Soap Box Derby car has sat at the top of a hill, ready to race in DuBois. Timberland Federal Credit Union is proud to be a car sponsor for the return of the Soap Box Derby in DuBois. The Timberland FCU car was raced on Saturday, June 20th in the stock division. Driving the car for Timberland FCU was 9 year old Timberland member Connor Fitzwater. Connor and his parents Tim and Lisa have spent the better



part of three months working Saturday mornings on the car at Timberland FCU. After a strenuous preseason of building and tweaking the car, testing it, and passing 2 official inspections performed by the Soap Box Derby, the car took to Long Avenue for the race on June 20th. Connor's first race was against car number five, driven by Jake LaMorte, sponsored by The Sound Garden. Connor lost his first race after being disqualified for having two wheels cross the center line. Connor lost his second race against the number 9 car driven by Eric Schneider, sponsored by Melillo Coin Laundry. The winners of the DuBois race were number 10, Jeremy Fischer driving for Tri-County Church in the stock division and number 29, driven by Adam Powell in the W.R. Day Memorial car in the super stock division. These two drivers will represent the DuBois Area in Akron, Ohio for the National Competition on July 25, 2009.
